

LITTER CLEAN-UP PROJECTS: GUIDELINES AND REQUEST FOR PERMISSION

This form must be submitted to the service unit manager or troop consultant along with the "Troop Activity: Request for Approval" form.

1. ___ Written parental/guardian permission is on file for each girl.
2. ___ Girl Health History Record is on file for each girl.
3. ___ Qualified first aider: _____
4. ___ Sponsoring Organization: _____
(Sponsoring organization must provide training in safety and proper disposal of trash).
5. ___ Girls and adults understand safety rules.
6. ___ Each girl's ability to carry out the project has been assessed (ability to follow safety rules, stamina to carry out the project).
7. ___ Girls and adults wear protective clothing including gloves, closed-toe shoes, and clothes appropriate to environmental conditions, i.e., protection from sun, branches, etc.
8. ___ Girls have received instruction on the following:
 - How to safely pick up and dispose of sharp objects.
 - Do not lift heavy objects.
 - Do not touch stranded animals (report to animal control).
 - Do not handle medical waste (report to the sponsoring organization or local law enforcement agency).
 - Do not handle large drums or metal canisters - report to the sponsoring organization or local law enforcement agency.
 - Do not handle feces - animal or human waste.
 - How to avoid traffic hazards.
9. ___ Girls and adults dispose of trash as directed by the sponsoring agency or ask permission of owner to use a private dumpster.
10. ___ Girls and adults understand that natural items such as driftwood, ground cover and wild flowers should not be removed from the project area.
