Troop/Group Services

Sponsors can provide many services to Girl Scout troops/groups. The sponsor agrees to provide the services below:

Girl Scout troops/groups are capable of providing many services for sponsors. The troop/group agrees to provide the services checked below:

- Provide a meeting place
- Provide financial assistance for troop or group members*
- Provide girl handbooks and recognition items (pins, badges and patches)*
- Provide camping equipment for the troop/group (tents, cook sets, lanterns, etc.)
- Assist in recruitment of volunteers who work with the troop or group
- Provide career exploration opportunities for the troop/group
- Provide transportation for the troop/group to locations other than the regular meeting place (e.g. camping, field trips)
- Provide publicity for Girl Scouting in company newsletters, etc.

- Keep sponsor informed of major activities planned and the needs of the girls
- Always leave the meeting place in its original condition or better
- Include the sponsor in appropriate activities
- Recognize and actively publicize the sponsor's contribution to the stability of the troop/group

Troop sponsorship is a voluntary partnership between Girl Scout troops and community organizations working together to bring Girl Scouting to all girls.

The sponsoring organization may provide the items show above. Financial support is \$250 maximum annually per troop (there may be more than one financial sponsor for a combined total of \$250).

All charitable contributions shall be made only to the Girl Scouts of Citrus Council. Incorporated in the state and designated as a 501(c)3 organization, the Council is the only tax exempt entity. Monetary contributions should provide on the check or with correspondence, the troop number. Any additional amount over the \$250 will be placed in the scoutership fund to benefit all girls in the council.

Both Girl Scouts of Citrus Council, Inc., and the Sponsor agree:

- To know and respect each other's aims and objectives
- That the Girl Scout Council assumes authority for administering the Girl Scout program within the framework of national and local Girl Scout policies and standards
- That the Girl Scout Council assumes final authority for selecting, appointing, training and supervising troop leaders
