COMMUNITY ROLES	KEY RESPONSIBILITIES
Operations Lead	The Operations Lead will develop and support the Service Community Team to ensure the success of administrative operations, such as finances, communication, and other logistics. The Operations Lead works collaboratively with other members.
Experiences Lead	The Experiences Lead will develop and support the Service Community to support girls, volunteers, and troops in implementing the Girl Scout Leadership Experience, National Program Portfolio, council program initiatives, and local events. The Experiences Lead works collaboratively with other members.
Community Fall Product Chair	The Community Fall Product Chair will ensure all aspects of the Fall Product Sweets 'N' Treats Program are implemented within the Service Community.
Community Cookie Chair	The Community Cookie Chair will ensure all aspects of the Girl Scout Cookie Program are implemented within the Service Community.
GIFTs for Girls Coordinator	The Gifts for Girls Coordinator will champion the signature "Gifts for Girls" fund development campaign.
Event Team Coordinator	The Event Team Coordinator will engage girls and volunteers in the Girl Scout Leadership Experience and National Program Portfolio via events. The Event Team Coordinator will support the Events Team to execute Service Community planned events.
Safety Coordinator	The Safety Coordinator will educate and inspire girls and volunteers in all areas of safety and preparedness, by assisting in interpreting written guidelines, procedures, and safety standards.
New Troop Mentor	Welcome, support, and empower new troop leaders as they get started in their Girl Scout Leadership Experience. Mentor them throughout their first year by helping to plan their year in VTK, first meetings, and attend (when possible). The New Troop mentor will serve as the VTK cheerleader in the Service Community.
Juliette Coordinator	Coordinate all aspects of the Juliette Program within the Community, including Fall Product Program, Cookie Program, and the Girl Scout Learning Experience.
Engagement Coordinator	Engagement Coordinator will develop and execute an effective recruitment plan for their Service Community. They will also assist with the placement of new members. This is a contracted position through Girl Scouts of Citrus Council.

COMMUNITY ROLES	KEY RESPONSIBILITIES
Communications Coordinator	The Communications Coordinator will ensure all aspects of communication within and out of the Service Community are effective and engaging.
Community Treasurer	The Community Treasurer will ensure the financial health of the Service Community through accurate record-keeping and reporting, as well as educating and supporting Troop Leaders in managing Troop finances, when appropriate.
Recognition Coordinator	The Recognition Coordinator will ensure volunteers within the Community are recognized and shown appreciation year-round and through their Girl Scout experience.
Events Team Member	The Event Team Member will create Service Community events for girls, volunteers, and troops that support the Girl Scout Leadership Experience and National Program Portfolio. They will work collaboratively with the Event Team Coordinator and Service Community to ensure the events align with the needs of the Service Community.
Camporee Coordinator	The Camporee Coordinator will be responsible for the management and execution of all aspects of a successful camporee.
Product Booth Coordinator	The Product Booth Coordinator is responsible for securing and organizing booth locations for the Fall Product and Cookie programs. This role involves coordinating with local businesses to schedule booth times. This role will collaborate with the Community Fall Product Chair and Community Cookie Chair.
Spirit Champion	The Spirit Champion is responsible for keeping the spirit of the Girl in all Service Community activities. The Spirit Champion is a girl position that supports other team positions such as GIFTs for Girls Coordinator, Camporee Director, ect.
Communication Champion	The Communications Champion will support the Communications Coordinator to ensure all aspects of communication within and outside of the Service Community are effective and engaging. The Communications Champion is a girl position.
Events Champion	The Events Champion will support the Events Team in planning and executing Service Community Events that interest the girls and troops. The Events Champion is a girl position.
