

Permission to Travel for Minors

Girl Scout minors under the age of 18 or that are still listed as a girl member, that are traveling outside of the state of Florida to any location, Domestic or International when not accompanied on the trip by their parent(s)/legal guardian(s), must have a notarized affidavit from the parent(s)/legal guardian(s) not accompanying the child that:

1. The child is traveling out of the state of Florida with the permission of the parent(s)/legal guardian(s).
2. The non-traveling parent(s)/legal guardian(s) will be provided with all travel dates, all transportation details, locations, itineraries, lodging locations and will be provided with contact information.
3. The name(s) and contact numbers, of the person(s) accompanying the child.

Please Note: Girls under 18 will not be able to board the international flight without this permission.

If the minor child is leaving the country without either of his/her parent(s), both parent(s) must provide a notarized signed affidavit as outlined.

Both parent(s)/legal guardian(s) must sign the permission form, which **MUST** be notarized. If the parents are not together, parent consent from both parents is still necessary. If one parent is the custodial parent or deceased, there **MUST** be legal proof/documentation of this status.
