




CADETTE, SENIOR & AMBASSADOR Service to Girl Scouting Bar Application & Evaluation Form

Girl Scout Cadette, Seniors and Ambassadors can choose to volunteer 20 hours (minimum) to the Girl Scout organization. Ideas include: volunteering at a special event for younger girls, volunteering at the council office, volunteering at a Service Unit event.

There are three types of Service to Girl Scouting Bars that girls are eligible to receive:

- The Cadette Girl Scout Community Service Bar (Green with Red) 
- The Senior Girl Scout Community Service Bar (Green with Orange) 
- The Ambassador Girl Scout Community Service Bar (Green with Yellow) 

Follow these steps toward earning and acquiring the Service to Girl Scouting Bar:

1. The girl completes a minimum of 20 service hours. This does not include the training period.
2. Use this Time Log to record the volunteer hours.
3. The girl obtains approval from the appropriate representative on the Time Log.
4. The girl submits the Time Log to the Troop Leader for final approval, with her signature.
5. The Troop Leader or parent takes the completed to the Council Store to purchase the Award.

Note A: Retail Store Staff will collect this form. Please make a copy for your records prior to shopping.

Note B: Parent signature is accepted, in lieu of Troop Leader, for Juliette.

Note C: Girl Scouts who have earned the Service to Girl Scouting Bar (at any of the levels) may continue their service with the same Girl Scout group after bridging to Senior or Ambassador. Girls should begin a new Time Log for the new Grade Level.
