Brevard County Library History

The first library in Brevard County was founded in 1895 in Cocoa, FL. One room was rented for five dollars a month, and women in the community would take turns volunteering to run it. The books and supplies were donated by local citizens. By 1959, four other libraries were established in the county, and Florida Statute 150 gave funding to these libraries in agreement that they would serve all residents. The first five public libraries in the county were Cocoa, Cocoa Beach, Eau Gallie, Melbourne, and one servicing North Brevard in Titusville. With the Space Program boom in the 1960s, Brevard County's population grew, and the five libraries were expanded to nine. By November 1972, it was necessary for voters to approve a tax referendum that would establish a Library Tax District to fund the growing library system's budget. Currently, there are seventeen libraries within the Brevard County Library System.



How to sign up for a Library Card

To get a three-year Resident Card, show a photo ID and proof of Brevard County residency. Juvenile cards require a parent or legal guardian's proof of residency.

Accepted ID to prove residency:

- Florida driver's license or vehicle registration with a Brevard County address
- Property tax receipt, deed, or mortgage
- Minimum six-month lease
- Valid Brevard County voter registration card
- Declaration of domicile and citizenship issued by Brevard County
- Florida Highway Patrol ID card
- Active duty military or dependent ID
- Access Florida card

Temporary Card

To get a temporary card you must have a photo ID and ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

- Lease for 30 days up to six months
- Current utility bill
- Checkbook with local address
- Current rent receipt or rent deposit receipt

Temporary cards are good for six months and are not renewable.

Non-Resident cards can be issued to students with an active Brevard County college ID or college library card. A non-resident may purchase a one-year library card with proof of their permanent address for \$15.

Rules and Conduct

The Brevard County Library System has adopted the Rules of Conduct to protect the right of individuals to access Library materials, services, and programs; to protect the right of Library staff to conduct Library business and pursue the goals of the Library's Mission without improper interference; to protect the right of customers and employees to enter and exit the Library's property without impediment, annoyance, or distraction from non-Library activities; and to protect Library materials and facilities from harm.
