



Authorization for Medical Treatment for Adults

If an adult requires medical attention, they must be able to give consent. If a situation arises that you are not able to give your consent, you must authorize a family member and/or another adult to give consent on your behalf. When traveling outside of the state of Florida on a designated Girl Scout trip, you must authorize at least one other adult that will be on the trip in case your family is not able to be reached. The following that authorizes the designated adult(s) listed below permission to authorize medical/dental treatment on the parent(s)/legal guardian(s) behalf.
