

Summer Camp 2021 Quick Fact Sheet

What types of camp will be available this Summer?

- We will host the following types of camps
 - Resident Camp- Limited capacity
 - Mah-Kah-Wee - 6 Weeks
 - Riverpoint – 1 week
 - Day Camp – Limited capacity
 - Pine Castle – 3 weeks
 - Virtual Camp
 - 3 weeks
 - Riverpoint Events/Programs
 - Throughout the Summer Riverpoint will also be used to host various programs and events
 - Field Trips
 - There will be no field trips or off-site activities
 - Trading Post/Camp Bags
 - Camp Bags will be available for purchase prior to camp for \$30
 - As of now the Trading Post will not be available, but could change

How can I register for Summer Camp?

- Camp Registrations will be taken through CampDoc
- The link can be found on the Summer Camp page of the website

When will registration open? Is there an early bird discount?

- Registration will open on March 15th,2021
- You must register and pay the deposit to hold your campers space
- Anyone that registers and pays in full by April 20th will receive \$50 off their camp fee
- When a camp is full, campers can request to be put on the waitlist

What weeks is camp taking place?

- Week 1- June 20-25, 2021 (MKW & Virtual)
- Week 2- June 27- July 2, 2021(MKW & Pine Castle)
- Week 3- July 5 – 9 2021 (MKW & Virtual)
- Week 4- July 11 – 16 2021(MKW, RVPT, & Pine Castle)
- Week 5 – July 18 – 23 2021(MKW & Virtual)
- Week 6 – July 25 – 30 2021(MKW & Pine Castle)

Can we apply for Financial Assistance or use Program Credits?

- Limited financial aid will be available to cover a percentage of the camp fee for those that qualify. Program credits that have been issued can also be applied towards the fee.
 - Please Note: You must register and pay the deposit to hold your spot while submitted your financial aid or program credit request

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How will the campers participate in activities throughout the day?

- For all in person sessions campers will be assigned to specific pods(groups) that they will be with throughout the session for all activities, meals and sleeping (at resident camp)
- If your camper is requesting a buddy they MUST be in the same session, no exceptions.

Safety and Covid-19 Guidelines

- Staff and campers will be required to always wear mask except during water activities and sleeping
- Pods(Groups) will only have interaction within their group
- All session attendance will be reduced by 50%
- Sleeping quarters will be limited by 50% and special sleeping guidance will be provided
- Additional sanitizer stations will be installed at all locations
- Hand washing will be done after all activities
- Individual supplies will be provided for each pod/group and sanitized daily
- All activity supplies will be sanitized between each pod/group
